

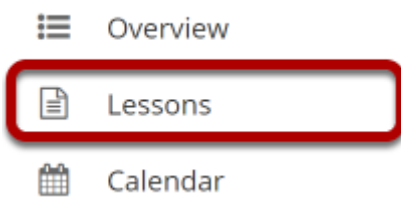
# How do I create multiple sections on a Lessons page?

When content items are added to a Lessons page, everything is displayed in a linear order vertically in one block without any visual section breaks. Adding multiple sections on a Lessons page breaks up this one big block into smaller blocks so that the page is more readable and visually more appealing.

A section is defined as one block of info flanked with light gray lines. One section may contain one or multiple columns.

Creating sections involves three steps.

## Go to Lessons.



Click on the Lessons tool in the Tool Menu to display the page.

*Note: The Lesson page must already contain content before adding sections.*

# Click an item's + button and Add Section Break Above.
